January Topics:

- The National Park Service denied our request for the Brown's Gap Challenge.
 Ostensibly due to its being a competitive event. We have appealed.
- Augusta Cycling Challenge is designed to promote the 3 known rides in the county,
 1)Tour de Valley, 2) Queen City, and 3)Veterans, plus participation in our club rides.
 There are 3 levels of award given:
 - 400 mile challenge: a free jersey is received as a prize for riding in all three events and totalling 400 miles of events in Augusta County, in any combination of mileage
 - 300 mile challenge: a half-priced jersey is provided as a prize for riding in all three events and totalling 300 miles of events in Augusta County, in any combination of mileage
 - Participation challenge: a jersey is provided at cost as a prize for participation in all three events, no mileage requirement.
- We need to schedule: Road clean-up days, fundraising activities, training classes, Ride Leader Training
- We need a shared file to cover all those who have signed the waiver for ride participation. This would help ride leaders out when the time comes. (discuss with Wes)
- VDOT is not willing to provide us with signage for road clean-up days, should we purchase our own sign?
- StableCraft has contacted us and desires to host an event. Possibly a Gravel ride?
- Ride Leader training is scheduled for February 12th at The Bridge. It will cover
 - Intro: What is a ride leader? Why do we need one? VA Bike Laws
 - Hand Signals, Pace Line dynamics, Emergency response procedures
 - How to create a map on "RidewithGPS"
 - Waiver requirements
